

Terms and Conditions of Hometown Contractors, Inc. Referral Program

Here are the few other terms and conditions we want you to know about:

1. Hometown Contractors, Inc. decides if a person is truly a referral or not. If we already have the person's name and address in our system, for example, we can't consider them as a new referral. Obviously, the referral must be newly entered into our system as your referral prior to the first appointment. The referral must meet with us within 30 days of the referral to qualify.
2. The referral **MUST** be a homeowner and located within our service area. All homeowners must be present at the time of the presentation.
3. A referred person can't be considered as a new referral until they have actually bought and paid for a Hometown Contract, Inc. job with at least a \$2500 purchase price, within a year of being referred to us.
4. If two or more people refer the same new customer to us at the same time, we will decide who gets the credit for the referral.
5. Only one referral per address, to keep things fair. If we believe that the referrals you send us are not really being submitted in good faith, we do reserve the right to disqualify the referrals. You cannot refer yourself.
6. Liability for any federal, state, and local taxes that may apply to referral fees paid to you are your responsibility. Any required tax reporting forms will be furnished to the Internal Revenue Service. Referral entries that are lost, late, illegible or incomplete for any reason will not be eligible, and Hometown Contractors, Inc. reserves the right to modify, suspend or terminate this promotion at any time, without notice, and to disqualify any entry in good faith.
7. Employees, agents, officers and directors of Hometown Contractors, Inc., its affiliates, subsidiaries, contractors, and their immediate families (and those living in their same households) are not eligible to participate in this promotion in any way.
